FUNDRAISING CONSULTANT FOR PUBLIC LIBRARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Consistent with the City of Riviera Beach Code of Ordinance (MUNICODE Section 16.5), a Request for Proposals (RFP) 757-16 was advertised in the "Legal Notices" section of the Palm Beach Post on May 01, 2016, to solicit qualified proposers for Fundraising Consultants interested in managing a Capital Campaign to raise funds to build a new public library. To provide additional exposure and to ensure maximum competition for the project, it was also advertised on the City's internet web-page on May 02, 2016. One (1) proposal was received.

On **June 21, 2016**, an evaluation committee consisting of the following convened to review the responses to the RFP for services of a Fundraising Consultant to raise funds to build a new public library:

Firms were evaluated and ranked based on the criteria established in the City's RFQ, as follows:

The evaluation process has validated that the proposal submitted by Brakeley Briscoe, Inc. satisfies the requirements established in the RFP and that the company is qualified to be awarded the contract for the services identified in RFP #757-16. The company has substantial experience in providing the types of services required by the City. This project will be managed by George Brakeley from the office located at 230 New Canaan Ave., #20, Norwalk, CT 06850, phone 203-912-3362,

Brakeley Briscoe is proposing to conduct this assignment providing their services as described in the proposal for the fixed fee of \$29,000, plus expenses. According to the proposal neither the library nor its foundation has 501c3 status, which is essential to philanthropic fundraising. Creation of a 501c3 entity, which consist of the application for such status and to put in place the necessary structure (by laws, a rudimentary board, etc.), would entail an incremental fee of \$2,500 plus expenses.

Accordingly, and consistent with the provisions of the solicitation, the evaluation committee hereby recommends award to Brakeley Briscoe, Inc. for providing a Fundraising Consultant to manage a Capital Campaign to raise funds to build a new public library for The City of Riviera Beach.
