A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE RELATED TO HURRICANE MATTHEW AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2016, President Barack Obama issued a Major Disaster Declaration designated FEMA-4283-DR-FL for the State of Florida as a result of Hurricane Matthew; and

WHEREAS, the Declaration, authorizes Public Assistance funding for eligible disaster recovery efforts in Bradford, Brevard, Clay, Duval, Flagler, Indian River, Lake, Martin, Nassau, Palm Beach, Putnam, Seminole, St. Johns, St. Lucie, and Volusia Counties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach requested public assistance based on expenses related to Hurricane Matthew and the request was approved and now we are required to enter into an agreement with Florida Division of Emergency Management.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the City Council authorizes the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an agreement with Florida Division of Emergency Management for the federally funded public assistance funding agreement related to Hurricane Matthew FEMA-4283-DR-FL.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the City Council.
