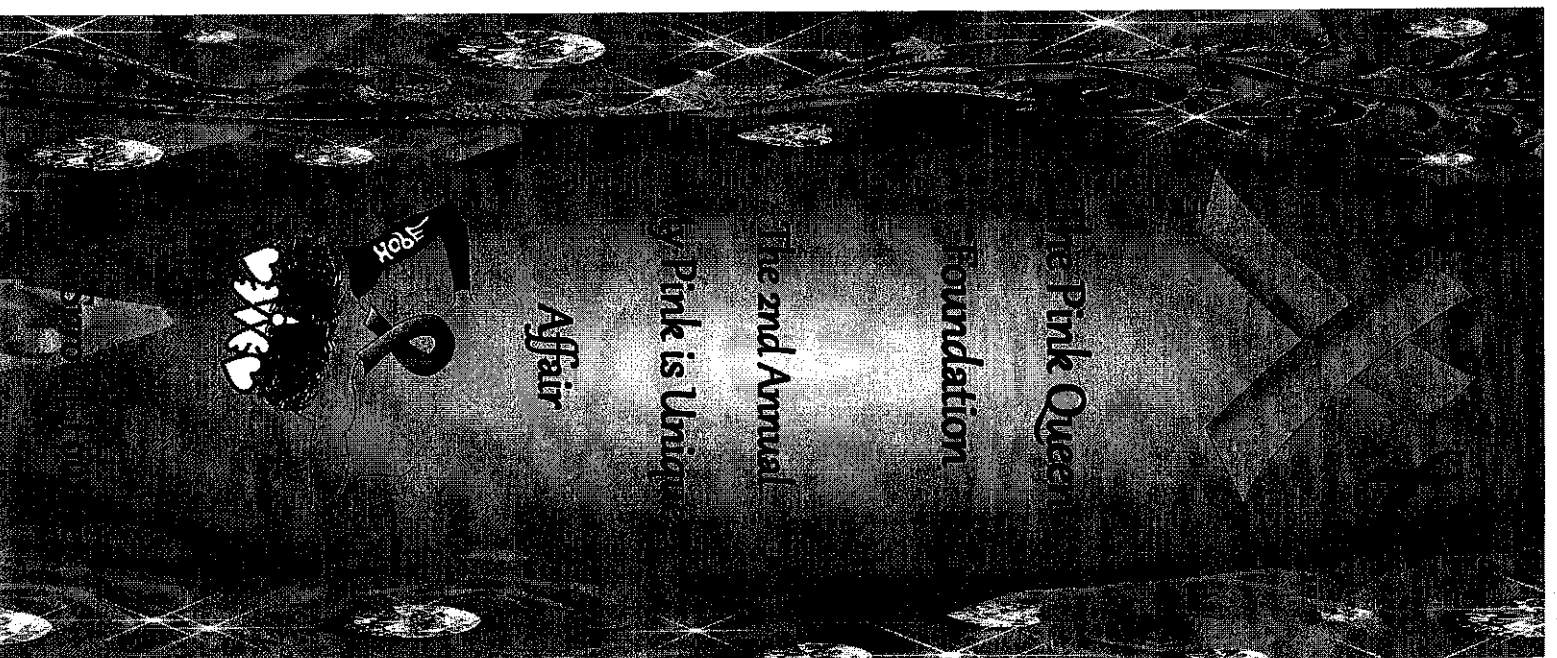

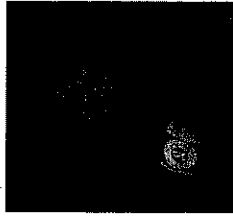

Waste Management Community Benefits Request for Donations

The City of Riviera Beach, in conjunction with Waste Management Inc. of Florida, has established a Community Benefits Policy. Funds cannot be given to an entity/agency/organization for which the elected official is a director or officer.


