WHEREAS, Tradrick McCoy., brought suit against the City of Riviera Beach and Lynne Hubbard, in her official capacity as City Councilperson for the City of Riviera Beach; Claudene Anthony, as City Clerk and Custodian of Records, and

WHEREAS, Tradrick McCoy, as Plaintiff, alleged that the City violated Article I, Section 24 of the Florida Constitution and the Public Records Act and Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, by failing to respond to his requests in a timely fashion; and

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2019, members of the City Council attended a closed door executive session with Counsel for the City to discuss potential settlement of this case; and

WHEREAS, the Counsel for the City has negotiated and proposed a settlement agreement on the matter with Mr. McCoy, to settle the case for all documented costs, not to exceed \$1,000, and the total costs of mediation, subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the City finds approving the Settlement Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", and authorizing payment of \$1,000 and the cost of mediation is in the best interests of the City and serves a valid public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That settlement in the matter of Tradrick McCoy v. City of Riviera Beach, Lynne Hubbard, in her official capacity as City Councilperson for the City of Riviera Beach, and Claudene Anthony, City Clerk, Case No. 50-2018-CA-015244, is hereby approved in the amount of \$1,000, plus the costs of mediation.

SECTION 2. That the City approves the Settlement Agreement and authorizes payment in accordance with the same.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the City Council.
