I love tackling tough challenges and finding practical solutions – especially when working with high-performance teams of professionals in different fields.

My most satisfying project – which directly relates to Riviera Beach -- was a 3+ year effort to build a new 175,000 sq. ft., 3-building office / technology campus in Colorado Springs.

- The CEO of SI International gave me primary responsibility to create a world-class facility to house over 450 employees supporting our customer at US Air Force Space Command.
- I worked directly with the mayor and key city officials as we competitively selected a vacant 10+ acre plot with views of Pikes Peak. We continued with monthly meetings throughout the design, approval, construction, occupancy and turn-over of the facility.
- During the construction phase, we faced many challenges but our team remained focused on collaboration and commitment to the end goal. There was no ‘finger pointing’ or in-fighting – just focus on finding the best solution to the issue at hand.
- The campus opened *on time* and *under budget*. The entire complex was praised by the mayor, city inspectors, SI leadership and Board of Directors and, more importantly, by our Air Force customer.
- Ten years later, at a reunion of the construction team, each of the top three construction executives continued to declare this was THE MOST successful and satisfying project in their 40+ years in the construction industry.



In short, our high-performance team created a great place to work that was beautiful, practical and affordable -- and brought lasting value to the neighborhood and the city.

I believe the experience I gained during this project can help Riviera Beach refine processes where necessary and help balance and protect the interests of the government, the neighborhoods, the local businesses, and the construction teams.
