

# Community Resilience Presentation Outline

**Community Resilience, as defined by Presidential Policy Directive (PPD) 8 – National Preparedness and the National Preparedness Goals (NPG),** is the ability of a community to adapt to changing conditions, withstand disruption, and rapidly recover from emergencies. Community resilience to hazards, including the impacts associated with climate change, is an element of overall national security and resilience and is a priority goal of the Federal Government.

## **National Preparedness Goal Alignment**

The Draft Concept Paper provides a structured approach for aligning national-level community resilience indicators and building out a suite of relevant measures that align with the **National Preparedness Goal**. The top level of the structure consists of **10 core capabilities** associated with the mitigation and recovery mission areas under the National Preparedness Goal:

- Housing
- Health and Social Services
- Economic Recovery
- Infrastructure Systems
- Natural and Cultural Resources
- Threats and Hazards Identification
- Risk and Disaster Resilience Assessment
- Planning
- Community Resilience
- Long-Term Vulnerability Reduction
