Background:

Community Resilience, as defined by Presidential Policy Directive (PPD) 8 – National Preparedness and the National Preparedness Goals (NPG), is the ability of a community to adapt to changing conditions, withstand disruption, and rapidly recover from emergencies. Community resilience to hazards, including the impacts associated with climate change, is an element of overall national security and resilience and is a priority goal of the Federal Government.
