Background:

Palm Beach County, through its Drowning Prevention Coalition ("DPC") Learn to Swim Program distributes vouchers to the public that may be redeemed for swimming lessons at designated aquatic facilities within Palm Beach County. The City's Parks and Recreation Department has offered DPC vouchers for the past 11 years. The vouchers provide free swim lessons to individuals at the Barracuda Bay Aquatic Complex, which is a designated facility.

All swim lessons are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Swim lessons for residents are \$30.00 and \$40.00 for non-residents per two-week sessions. Swim lessons are offered at Barracuda Bay Aquatic Complex from April 2020 through September 2020.

Citywide Goal:

The City-wide goal is to strengthening community engagement.



Budget/Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal budget impact at this time. The Drowning Prevention Program vouchers cover all costs of swim lessons benefiting eligible participants (the County reimburses the City at 100%).

Recommendation(s):

Staff recommends that the City Council authorizes approval of the Inter-local Agreement between the City of Riviera Beach and the Palm Beach County Drowning Prevention Coalition for the acceptance of vouchers to cover the costs of swim lessons for eligible participants.
