

Waste Management Community Benefits Request for Donations

The City of Riviera Beach, in conjunction with Waste Management Inc. of Florida, has established a Community Benefits Policy. Under the Policy each elected official shall be entitled to designate funds to support approved public projects for public purposes. Public purposes include, but are not limited to, charitable events, not-for-profit organizational events or programs and City functions or projects (which may include contributions to the City's Scholarship Fund or the City's Housing Trust Fund). All requests for donations must be presented to the City Council and approved by a majority of the City Council. The City will attempt to process all requests within fourteen (14) days of City Council approval.

Ineligible uses include the purchase of tables at events, campaign contributions, or payment for salaries or operational expenses. Funds cannot be used to cover an elected official's travel, meals, or for his or her personal benefit or gain or for the personal gain of relatives as defined by City Code, the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics or State Statutes, as applicable. Funds cannot be given to an entity/agency/organization for which the elected official is a director or officer.

She Speaks International, Inc. works with children and women that have or are currently experiencing domestic violence issues in their homes. We will be providing "We Care Workshops" in the community for children ages 4-14. "We Care Workshops" will discuss with the children COVID-19, the importance of social distancing, as well as normal Health and Safety. The workshops will give children the opportunity to express their feelings about the issues they are facing as young people during this time. We will also discuss issues young people deal with in school like race, peer pressure, and the social issues of today. Due to current regulations, group sizes will be 10 children or less. We will have both open and private conversations, with professional, as well as, dancing, painting, and reading.

Parents will be able to drop their children off for two hours so that they can run errands or simply have some much-needed free time. Over the past 14 weeks, we have experienced an increase in calls from mothers dealing with domestic issues. I have a connection with many mothers currently dealing with domestic violence. I have been certified in Child Development for over 30 years. I am a Certified Grief Counselor and have been ministering to women in these situations for several years. "We Care Workshops" are here to help better the whole person. Each participant will receive a personal toiletry set as well as literature that they can use at home.
