

RESOLUTION NUMBER 18-20UD

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH UTILITY SPECIAL DISTRICT, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PROPOSAL FROM BROWN AND CALDWELL FOR INDEPENDENT CONSULTING IMPLEMENTATION OF WATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT FINANCE DIRECTOR TO MAKE PAYMENTS FROM PROJECT NUMBER 18160 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$255,830.00; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach Utility Special District has a Contract dated August 20, 2018 with Brown and Caldwell (Consultant) to provide continuing professional consulting engineering services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Consultant's Competitive Negotiation Act, the Consultant has provided a proposal which does not exceed the maximum limit of \$500,000 for engineering studies; and

WHEREAS, Consultant, in a proposal requested by District, provided a scope of work and associated costs to identify issues and provide professional recommendations regarding critical processes within the water treatment plant, including filtration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH UTILITY SPECIAL DISTRICT, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Board of Directors of the City of Riviera Beach Utility Special District accepts the proposed scope of work to support Design Build projects underway, evaluate critical processes, and develop a framework for project management.

SECTION 2. That the Utility Special District Finance Director is authorized to make payments from Project Number 18160 for work authorization issued by the Executive Director of Utilities in an amount not to exceed \$255,830.00.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
