A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COUNTY, BEACH. PALM BEACH FLORIDA. APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE LORD'S PLACE, INC., AND THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA; ACCEPTING FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$267,500; FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF REENTRY SERVICES FROM OCTOBER 1, 2020 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2023; AUTHORIZING DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO SET UP A BUDGET FOR THE SAME AND **AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE** THE AGREEMENT AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- **WHEREAS**, the Justice Service Center has provided comprehensive reentry services in Palm Beach County since 2007; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Justice Service Center meets the requirements for administering offender reentry services; and
- **WHEREAS**, the purpose of the County-wide reentry effort is to reduce recidivism, rebuild ties between offenders and their families, protect the public, assist offenders in establishing a self-sustaining life and support evidence based practices; and
- **WHEREAS**, a community collaborative of The Lord's Place, Inc., Gulfstream Goodwill Industries and the Justice Service Center were awarded the Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Program's Second Chance Act Comprehensive Community-Based Adult Reentry Grant; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Lord's Place, Inc. is positioned as the lead agency and Gulfstream Goodwill and The Justice Service Center will function as Subrecipients; and
- WHEREAS, the Second Chance Act Comprehensive Community-Based Adult Reentry Grant community collaboration seeks to enhance the current reentry services offered by providing additional Case Management, Peer Advocates and Support Services for criminal justice-involved citizens.; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Lord's Place, Inc. has agreed to reimburse the CITY for the expenses in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$267,500) from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023 to provide reentry services.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute the Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Riviera Beach and The Lord's Place, Inc. for the Justice Service Center.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance and Administrative Services is authorized to set up a budget for the same:

Expenditures Salaries/Fringe Benefits Operational/ Expenses \$267,500

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval by City Council.
