## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 117-20**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY. FLORIDA. AUTHORIZING SEVEN **KINGS** HOLDINGS, AS THE THIRD PARTY MARINA MANAGER, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH WITH GREAT DANE PETROLEUM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$164,957, AUTHORIZING SEVEN KINGS TO INCUR ANCILLARY COSTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS UP TO A TOTAL MAXIMUM OF TEN PERCENT (10%) OF THE CONTRACT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- **WHEREAS**, there was a diesel fuel line break at the City of Riviera Beach Marina that has curtailed diesel fuel sales; and
- **WHEREAS**, Seven Kings Holdings has the responsibility to manage all aspects of the Marina operations, including repairs and maintenance of a capital nature; and
- **WHEREAS**, Seven Kings has obtained, reviewed, and qualified three (3) proposals; and
- **WHEREAS**, after qualifying the various submitted proposals, the recommendation is to proceed with Great Dane Petroleum as the vendor for this project; and
- **WHEREAS**, Seven Kings is anticipating ancillary costs up to \$25,000 including permitting, utility relocation, and soil contamination.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA that:

- **SECTION 1.** Seven Kings Holdings is authorized to enter into a contract with Great Dane Petroleum in an amount of \$164,957.
- **SECTION 2.** Seven Kings is authorized to incur ancillary project costs not to exceed \$25,000.
- **SECTION 3.** The City Manager is authorized to approve changes up to a total maximum amount of ten percent (10%) of the contract.
- **SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the City Council.
