Under the Policy each elected official shall be entitled to designate up to \$15,000 per year (\$7,500 on October 1st and \$7,500 on April 1st) for public

or operational expenses. Funds cannot be used to cover an elected official's travel, means, or for his or her personal benefit or gain or for the personal gain of relatives as defined by City Code, the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics, or state statues, as applicable. Funds cannot be given to an entity/agency/organization for which the elected official is a director or officer. Ineligible uses include the purchase of tables at events, campaign contributions, or payment for salaries
