Background:

The purpose of the Derelict Vessel Removal Grant is to reimburse the City of Riviera Beach for removal and disposal of two derelict vessels from public waters of the State of Florida within the City of Riviera Beach's Police Department jurisdiction.

The vessels designated for removal are as follows:

White 32' Egg Harbor Cabin Cruiser (Reg: FL8300HV/HIN: EGH33136M82D) and
White 35' Albin Trawler (Reg: FL7072FY/HIN: HHG361156M78D)

There is no conflict with any existing City Policy in this Agenda Item.



Citywide Goal:

The removal and disposal of these derelict vessels will improve boating safety by removing hazards to navigation. This project will also help to restore sensitive marine resources and improve water quality.

Budget/Fiscal Impact:

The City of Riviera Beach will be reimbursed for all labor, equipment, and materials to remove and dispose of two derelict vessels in an amount not to exceed \$16,720.00.

All invoices and closeout documents for work completed must be submitted by no later than January 29, 2021.

Recommendation(s):

Staff recommends that the City Council approves the Resolution authorizing acceptance of the Derelict Vessel Removal Grant, Contract No. 20155.
