**Background:**

Consistent with the City of Riviera Beach **Code of Ordinance (MUNICODE Section 16.5)**, an Invitation to Bid was advertised in the Palm Beach Post on **November 18, 2020**, to solicit contractors for Emergency Generators at Public Works, Brooks Center and Lindsay Davis Center.

To provide additional exposure and to ensure maximum competition for the project, it was also advertised on the City's website / Demand Star on **November 16, 2020**. The bids were received on **January 7, 2021**. Bids were received from Zabatt Power Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$652,741.04 and All-Site Construction, Inc. in the amount \$881,493.00.
