

Zabatt Power Systems:

1. Confirm missile impact generator enclosures are required. Confirm there are no remote annunciators. Confirm E-stops will be required (none shown).

Answer: Missile impact enclosure eliminates the need for walls around generator. Remote annunciators are part of the generator package. They are to be installed in the building engineer's office of the building the generator is serving. There is also an auto dialer that calls a remote number to report generator status. E-stops are required and are part of the generator package.

2. Brooks Center: Are we supplying the ATS as drawings conflict: E-1 Packaged Electrical System Note 1 states existing, E-2 riser shows 260 amp SER with 225 amp CB, please clarify.

Answer: Note 1 on E-1 should not indicate transfer switch as existing. The riser diagram, which indicates a new transfer switch, is correct.

3. Brooks Center: Panel feeding generator circuits: PES note 15 states new panel, lights, receptacles in new gen enclosure while E-2 shows circuits from panel LA?

Answer: PES note 15 should not indicate a panel in the enclosure. Drawing E-2 is correct. The circuits are to be fed from existing panel LA as indicated.

4. Brooks Center: How are we to deal with power outage for ATS install?

Answer: Any power outage or shutdowns will be scheduled during the weekend days.

5. Brooks Center: Are we to include mobile generator or can site be down for a day. Please clarify.

Answer: Any power outage or shutdowns will be scheduled during the weekend days.

6. Lindsay Davis: Panel feeding generator circuits same as Brooks above, PES note 15 vs E-2 shows new panel G.

Answer: PES Note 15 should not indicate a panel in the enclosure. Drawing E-2 is correct. The circuits are to be fed from new panel G as indicated.

7. Lindsay Davis: Please clarify, power outage question same as Brooks site above.

Answer: Any power outage or shutdowns will be scheduled during the weekend days.

8. Public Works: E-1 General note 8 states wire to be copper THWN, E-2 shows new wiring to be Aluminum XHHW-2. Clarify.

Answer: General note 8 applies to any new wiring that is not specified differently.

9. Public Works: E-2 shows 2000 amp generator breaker with five sets of 600KCM aluminum XHHW-2. This wiring only rated for 1700 amps. Clarify.

Answer: E-2 indicates five sets of 600kcm aluminum XHHW-2 for the new emergency power feeder to match the existing normal power feeder. 600KCM XHHW-2 aluminum is rated for 385 amps.

10. Public Works: Where are we feeding new panel in the generator from? Please advise.

Answer: Normal and emergency feeders are rated for 1925 amps. Transfers switch circuit breaker trip should be adjusted accordingly.

11. Brooks Center & Lindsay Davis: Dwg E-1; Transfer Switch Section; Note 7 states "It shall be possible to start and run the generator set for up to 72 hours and control the transfer of the load to the generator set". Confused about the 72 hours (is this a gas generator?). Maybe this note is concerning a function to exercise the generator. Just needing more clarification and/or details on this note 7.

Answer: Note 7 refers to a switch on the remote annunciator that enables you to start the unit remotely. Because this is natural gas and an unlimited fuel supply, it is timed out to maximum 72-hour run when started remotely.
