A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH UTILITY SPECIAL DISTRICT, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH UNDERWATER SOLUTIONS INC., MATTAPOISETT, MASSACHUSETTS; COOPERATIVE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL RFP18 4601 OQ, ORLANDO UTILITIES COMMISSION FOR INSPECTIONS AND INTERIOR CLEANINGS (SEDIMENT REMOVAL) OF STORAGE TANKS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$39,220.00; AUTHORIZING THE UTILITY SPECIAL DISTRICT BOARD CHAIRPERSON AND DISTRICT CLERK TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS UP TO TEN PERCENT (10%); AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT FINANCE DIRECTOR TO MAKE PAYMENT FROM **PROJECT NUMBER** 21016 **AFTER** WORK **AUTHORIZATIONS HAVE** BEEN **ISSUED**; **AND** PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2016, Underwater Solutions Inc. conducted an inspection of the Utility Special District Water Treatment Plant 1-million gallon concrete water storage tank and removed the sediment accumulation found on the floor; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Special District next inspection and cleaning is due March 14, 2021, as is required by State law 62-555.350(2) F.A.C. for Operation and Maintenance of Public Water Systems; and

WHEREAS, finished-drinking-water storage tanks, including conventional hydropneumatic tanks, shall be cleaned at least once every five (5) years to remove biogrowths, calcium or iron/manganese deposits, and sludging from inside the tanks; and shall be inspected for structural and coating integrity at least once every five years by personnel under the responsible charge of a professional engineer licensed in Florida; and

WHEREAS, Orlando Utilities Commission ("OUC") posted a Request for Proposal, to wit, 4601 OQ, hereinafter the "RFP" for Inspections and Interior cleanings of storage tanks, the terms of which are incorporated; and

WHEREAS, the Underwater Solutions Inc. ("Supplier") was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the work and has awarded to the Supplier a contract effective January 19, 2019 through January 7, 2024; this contract has a renewal option of one (1) consecutive five (5) year period starting January 8, 2024; and

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WHEREAS, the contract allows Underwater Solutions Inc. to supply the subject services to other agencies under the same conditions and prices; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Special District wishes to utilize the cooperative agreement between Orlando Utilities Commission and Underwater Solutions Inc.; and

WHEREAS, a cooperative purchasing agreement will allow for preferred pricing for Inspections and Interior cleanings of storage tanks and an expeditious approach to meeting the regulatory requirement by the deadline.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, UTILITY SPECIAL DISTRICT, RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the Board of Directors of the City of Riviera Beach Utility Special District approves the contract with Underwater Solutions Inc. for Inspections and Interior cleanings of storage tanks for \$39,220.

SECTION 2: The District Finance Director shall be authorized to make payments from Project Number 21016 after work authorizations issued by the Utility Special District Interim Executive Director.

SECTION 3: The City Manager is authorized to approve change orders up to ten percent (10%).

SECTION 4: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute future renewals of this agreement.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage by the Utility Special District Board.
