

RESOLUTION NUMBER 18-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A WORK ORDER TO DEV-LAND DEMOLITION & SITE, INC., OF BOYNTON BEACH, FLORIDA TO DEMOLISH THE EXISTING WALGREENS AT BLUE HERON BOULEVARD AND CONGRESS AVENUE AND THE LIBRARY AT THE CITY HALL COMPLEX IN THE AMOUNT OF \$113,638.53 AND \$90,409.80 RESPECTIVELY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS UP TO TEN PERCENT (10%); AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO MAKE PAYMENT FOR SAME FROM PROJECT NUMBER 18034 AND 21010; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council approved RFQ 1003-20-4 for demolition construction continuing services through Resolution No. 113-20; and

WHEREAS, Dev-Land Demolition & Site, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$113,638.53 and \$90,409.80 respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby accepts the bid proposal and awards a work order to Dev-Land Demolition & Site, Inc., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount \$113,638.53 and \$90,409.80 for Walgreens and the Library respectively to demolish the existing structures at these sites.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance and Administrative Services is authorized to make payment for same from Project Numbers 18340 and 21010.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager shall have authority to approve change orders in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the contract amount.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval by City Council.
