**DECLARING THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY AS
BILE DUCT CANCER MONTH
IN THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH.**

WHEREAS, cholangiocarcinoma also known as Bile Duct cancer is a rare cancer that affects an estimated 20,000 people a year in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Bile Duct cancer is a rare disease to detect because it does not usually cause signs or symptoms until later in the course of the disease; and

WHEREAS, TanAngels4ever, Inc., is a 501(c)(3) organization whose mission is to bring awareness, educate others, support those affected by the disease, raise funds for research and awareness for Bile Duct Cancer and partner and collaborate with other organizations to bring awareness; and

WHEREAS, TanAngels was founded in memory of Tanya Gayle Ingraham, who passed away in 2017 after a courageous battle with this aggressive, silent and deadly disease; and

WHEREAS, the organization has hosted two Colors of Hope Brunches, where it brought awareness about Bile Duct Cancer and celebrated cancer warriors, survivors and caregivers, has delivered "300 TanAngels Gift Bags of Hope" which included healthcare products, inspirational items blankets and stuffed animals to cancer patients, and hosted the second annual 10K/5K Run/Walk on February 12, 2020 and assisted 53 cancer patients financially during 2020 fiscal year: and
