Background:

At its past meetings, the Utility Special District Board, hereinafter referred to as Board, was informed that staff has been researching various options to facilitate the production of a quality potable water system. Thereby, as a part of this effort, key staff in partnership with consultants are prepared to share with the Board its assessments and findings of such utility infrastructure and operating systems.

More specifically, staff from USD, the City Manager’s Office, Finance, Legal and Procurement are working collectively to provide options to design build and finance a modern water treatment facility. To this end, at this time, in concert with Colin Groff, a consultant of Black Creek Engineering, Inc. as outlined below, essential data has been compiled and is being presented through the following themes:

- o The Creation of the Utility Special District.
- o The Current Conditions of the Infrastructure and Operational Systems.
- o Options for the Development of a New Water Treatment Plant Facility.
