

RESOLUTION NUMBER 57-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL PROGRAM FEES AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach's goal is to accelerate operational excellence through creating and implementing procedures to achieve effective program management and compliance; and

WHEREAS, it is the City's intent to provide for a Cross Connection Control Program that is established in accordance with Florida Administrative Code 62-555.360; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously enacted Cross-Connection Control regulations to protect the City's drinking water system from contaminants; and

WHEREAS, cross-connections generally occur when there is a temporary or permanent connection between the City's public water system or consumer's potable water system and any source or system containing non-potable water or other substances, such as pool water or irrigation systems; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to prevent such contamination, backflow devices are designed to protect potable water from contaminants wherein piping may be cross-connected and such cross-connections cannot be eliminated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of public health and safety to ensure that all backflow preventers continue to properly operate; and

WHEREAS, the City will adopt new fees for the administration of the Cross Connection Control Program, which will be the initial testing fee, the annual testing fee, and additional testing associated with the devices; and

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach chooses to adopt these fees to ensure that adequate compensation is provided for services of which City resources are expended to conduct various activities associated with the Cross Connection Control Program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. A \$50 fee that is due at the time that an initial test report of a backflow device is submitted to the City for recording.

SECTION 2. A \$15 fee that is due at the time that an annual test report of a backflow device is submitted to the City for recording.

SECTION 3. A \$15 fee that is due at the time that a test report of a backflow device is submitted to the City for recording.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
