- record, my name is Deirdre Jacobs and I'm the Acting Executive Director of the Utility
- 142 Special District.

The Item before you this evening deals with change'.., or, the prospect of change orders that may take place with actual construction activities that are going on over at the Utility District at this particular time. When the dollar amounts were awarded for these projects back in the fall of 2020, there was no set aside for the ten percent contingency for change orders that may have.., that we envision would occur over that time.

It has become apparent that there will be change orders that will be needed in order to carry through with activities, work activities that are unforeseen. So, this particular Item asks for your permission to allow an additional ten percent to be awarded for this particular project. The dollar amount is approximately \$1MM or ten percenter of the, the six hundred and some odd thousand dollars, as well as the three hundred and some odd thousand dollars. I'm sorry, \$6MM and \$3MM.

- So with your consideration of the change order.., of the ten percent of those particular dollar amounts, we would be able to utilize those dollars to carry forward with any change orders that may be needed.
- 157 **Chairperson Lanier:** Thank you, Ms. Jacobs. Any discussion from the Board?
- 158 **Board Member McCoy:** Question.
- 159 **Chairperson Lanier:** Yes. Go ahead, sir.
- 160 **Board Member McCoy:** Ms. Jacobs, can you explain that again? You said ten percent
- 161 of \$6MM...

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- 162 Acting Executive Director Jacobs: No.
- 163 **Board Member McCoy:** ...would be...
- 164 Acting Executive Director Jacobs: No. Actually, I read the numbers wrong. The,
- the dollar amount is \$3,989,000 for the first contract. And the second one is \$6,630,000,
- 166 plus.
- 167 **Board Member McCoy:** And why wasn't there a contingency set up?
- 168 Acting Executive Director Jacobs: You know what? I can't tell you why it was not
- set up at that particular time. I, I would assume that it was an oversight.
- 170 **Board Member McCoy:** Okay. How much have we expended of the amount that was
- approved by this Board?
- 172 Acting Executive Director Jacobs: I believe we.., I'm sorry. I believe we've
- expended approximately \$4MM. Maybe three to \$MM of these... of this particular amount.
- 174 **Board Member McCoy:** Okay.

- 210 **District Finance Director Sherman:** Good evening everyone. Randy Sherman,
- 211 District Finance Director.
- This Resolution that you have before you is what is known as a Reimbursement
- 213 Resolution. Two weeks ago, you passed a similar Resolution for the fire stations in your
- other capacity. Again, what this Resolution does is, it draws the line in the sand that says
- anything from today's date forward that we expend on the water treatment plant, will be...
- will be eligible to be reimbursed from the bond proceeds. It doesn't mean you have to be
- reimbursed for it, but again, it just sets that line if you should desire to do that.
- And I can take any questions that you might have.
- 219 **Chairperson Lanier:** Any discussion from the Board? Yes, sir. Go ahead.
- 220 **Board Member McCoy:** Thank you. Mr. Sherman, you're the Director of Finance,
- 221 right?
- 222 **District Finance Director Sherman:** Yes.
- 223 **Board Member McCoy:** Okay. So we don't need the Administrative Services on that
- 224 Item. So I think that might have been a... something that's been carried forward, as it
- 225 relates to the Utility Special District. Also...
- 226 **District Finance Director Sherman:** Gotcha.
- 227 **Board Member McCoy:** ...this Item reads that it's in accordance with the City's debt
- 228 management policy. That wouldn't be applicable because this is the Utility Special
- 229 District. And I'm not sure that we have a Utility Special District debt management policy.
- 230 And if it is, I'm not familiar with it.
- 231 **District Finance Director Sherman:** The debt policy covers both. It covers all the
- 232 City's debt.
- 233 **Board Member McCoy:** Right. But, the Utility...
- 234 **District Finance Director Sherman:** And...
- 235 **Board Member McCoy:** ... District is not a part of the City. So, are we applying a policy
- that has not been adopted by the Utility District?
- 237 District Finance Director Sherman: But its... I know. This is where we get
- convoluted. The, the bonds that are actually.., as, as the Fi'.., Finance Director for the

- 239 City, I actually sign off on part of the bond, you know, the bond proceeds. I know that,
- again, the Charter does allow the District to issue it. They are issued under the District's
- name. The revenue supporting the bonds are the District's. But again, it, it's a [chuckle]
- it's a.., it gets to be a convoluted situation. But again, I.., part of it is I am signing off as
- the City's Finance Director.
- 244 **Board Member McCoy:** Okay. Follow up?
- 245 **Chairperson Lanier:** Yes. Go ahead.
- 246 **Board Member McCoy:** I would agree that it's convoluted, but the issuance of these
- bonds, specifically require those covenants where we don't give free service. Correct?
- 248 **District Finance Director Sherman:** Correct.
- 249 **Board Member McCoy:** Okay. So, but we did just that, at the last special meeting,
- where we waived the monies that was owed by the Town of Mangonia Park, which was
- 251 essentially wastewater services that was given free, contingent upon some future
- 252 wastewater rate.
- 253 **District Finance Director Sherman:** It was contingent on a Settlement Agreement. I
- 254 did run that by bond counsel. I did have both of the City's bond counsels review that
- 255 matter. And again, they said that the Board does have the authority to settle. You know?
- To sue and be sued. And, they didn't look at that, that was free service. That was a, a
- 257 settlement of a outstanding claim.
- 258 **Board Member McCoy:** Follow up? That is exactly what I wanna hear. The Board
- does have the ability to settle. So, anybody from the public, if you have discrepancies, or
- 260 you just can't afford to...
- 261 **District Finance Director Sherman:** No.
- 262 **Board Member McCoy:** ...pay your water bill, this Board does have the ability to settle
- your water bill. Because, we clearly did it for the Town of Mangonia Park, against my,
- you know, my opinions on it. So certainly, come on in, and the billing offices, well, the
- Utility District office will be happy to set up a settlement plan if you're not able.., unable to
- pay your water bill. Because surely, if we could do it for the Town of Mangonia Park, I
- don't see why we wouldn't be able to do it for our, our own municipal boundary customers.

And also, the other thing that I wanna bring up was, the [pause], you know, I don't

- understand that you said you ran it by bond counsel, but still, our very Charter prohibits
- free service in itself. So, aside from bond counsel which, if they signed off on it, I'm gonna
- make a formal request that I have whatever communications that they signed off agreeing
- to it. So, Ms. Executive Director, can you kindly have that shared with me?
- But certainly, it's also prohibited in our Utility District Charter to provide free service.
- 274 Certainly to the...
