#### **Background:**

In 2004, City Staff brought forward Resolution 23-04 codifying the maintenance obligation and reimbursement funding for street lights in the FDOT right of way within the corporate limits of the City of Riviera Beach. The FDOT provides funding allocation and reimburses the City for maintenance expenses for the same street lights.

The proposed contract amendments provide for the increased number of street lights installed within the FDOT right of way and escalating operational expenses. Staff request approval of the execution of this updated maintenance, lighting, and compensation agreement.
