- **SECTION 1.** Authorize the following road closures on January 15, 2022:
  - 1) Blue Heron Blvd. from Congress Ave, to Ave. L during the hours of 6:30 a.m. until 3 p.m.
  - 2) 13th Street from Ave R to Australian Ave. during the hours of 6:30 a.m. until 10 a.m.
  - 3) Ave. R from Blue Heron Blvd during the hours of 6:30 a.m. until 10 a.m.
