

Planting Notes:

COMMERCIAL FERTILIZER:

FERTILIZER SHALL BE COMPLETELY ORGANIC. IT SHALL BE UNIFORM IN COMPOSITION DRY AND FREE FLOUING. THIS FERTILIZER SHALL BE DELIVERED TO THE SITE IN THE ORIGINAL UNOPENED BAGS, EACH BEARING THE MANUFACTURER'S STATEMENT OF ANALYSIS, AND SHALL MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS: SIX PERCENT (6%) PHOSPHOROUS SIX PERCENT (6%) POTASSIUM

FERTILIZER SHALL BE APPLIED TO ALL SHRUBS (1/3 LB. PER 3 GAL, POT, 1/4 LB. PER 1 GAL, POT) AND GROUNDCOVER. THE SAME FERTILIZER MIXTURE SHALL BE USED ON SOD AT A RATE OF B LBS, PER 1000 SQUARE FEET. A FOURTEEN PERCENT (14%) NITROGEN, FOURTEEN PERCENT (14%) PHOSPHOROUS ND FOURTEEN PERCENT (14%) POTASSIUM IS REQUIRED ON ALL TREES AND SHRUBS OVER 5'-0" IN HEIGHT (1/2 LB. PER 5'-0" OF SPREAD). AGRIFORM TABLETS WITH TWENTY PERCENT (20%) NITROGEN, TEN PERCENT (10%) PHOSPHOROUS, FIVE PERCENT (5%) POTASSIUM IN 21 GRAM SIZES SHALL BE APPLIED ALONG WITH THE FERTILIZER PROCESS () WITH I GAL. PLANTS, 2 WITH 3 GAL. PLANTS AND 2 TABLETS PER I" OF TREE TRUNK CALIFER). BACK FILL HALFWAY UP THE ROOT BALL. PLACE ABOUT ONE INCH (I") FROM ROOT TIPS. MAGNESIUM SULFATE SHALL BE APPLIED TO ALL PALMS AT INSTALLATION AT A RATE OF 1/2 LB. PER INCH OF TRUNK CALIPER MANGANESE SHALL BE APPLIED AT THE SAME RATE.

MULCH:

MEASUREMENTS:

MULCH MATERIAL SHALL BE SHREDDED CYPRESS MULCH OR APPROVED EQUAL, MOISTENED AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION TO PREVENT WIND DISPLACEMENT. MULCH SHALL BE APPLIED TO A MINIMUM 3" DEPTH IN PLANTING BEDS.

THE 60D SHALL BE FREE PROM WEEDS, RINGUS, INSECTS AND DISEASES OF ANY KIND, CLEAN, STRONGLY ROOTED, UNIFORMLY SIZED STRIPS, MACHINE STRIPFED NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS

SUBSTITUTIONS: NO SUBSTITUTION OF PLANT MATERIAL TYPES OR SIZES WILL BE ALLOWED WITHOUT URITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE QUARK CONTAINER GROWN MATERIAL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS SUBSTITUTE FOR BUB MATERIAL UNLESS PREVIOUSLY APPROVED. INTENDED SUBSTITUTIONS SHALL BE SPELLED OUT IN BID.

SHADE TREES: HEIGHT SHALL BE MEASURED FROM GROUND TO THE AVERAGE BRANCH HEIGHT OF AROUND THE CROWN FROM THE CENTER OF THE TRUNK. MEASUREMENTS ARE NOT TO CLUDE ANY TERMINAL GROUTH. SINGLE TRUNK TREES SHALL BE PREE OF "V" CROTCHES THAT COULD BE POINTS OF WEAK LIMB STRUCTURE OR DISEASE INFESTATION.

HEIGHT SHALL BE MEASURED FROM THE GROUND TO THE AVERAGE POINT WHERE MATURE PLANT GROWTH STOPS. SPREAD SHALL BE MEASURED TO THE END OF BRANCHING EQUALLY AROUND THE SHRUB MASS. MEASUREMENT AREA NOT TO

CLEAR TRUNK (C.T.) - SHALL BE MEASURED FROM THE GROUND AT TIME OF INSTALLATION TO THE POINT WHERE THE MATURE AGED TRUNK JOINS THE IMMATURE OR GREEN PORTION OVERALL HEIGHT (O.A.) - SHALL BE MEASURED FROM THE GROUND AT THE TIME OF INSTALLATION TO THE AVERAGE FROND HEIGH PALMS WITH MARRED OR BURNED TRUNKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

PLANTING SOIL AND BACKFILL:

PLANTING SOIL FOR USE IN PREPARING BACKFILL FOR PLANT PITS SHALL BE A FERTILE, FRIABLE AND NATURAL TOPSOIL, WITHOUT MIXTURE OF SUBSOIL MATERIALS, AND SHALL BE FREE FROM HEAVY CLAY STONES, LIME, LUMPS, SHELLS, PLANTS, ROOTS OR OTHER FOREIGN MATERIALS, WEEDS, OR NOXIOUS GRASSES (SUCH AS BERTIDA OR NUT GRASS). IT SHALL NOT CONTAIN TOXIC SUBSTANCES WHICH MAY

BACKFILL FOR SOD AREAS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO LESSER STANDARDS AT THE DISCRETION AND DECISION OF THE QUINER. EXISTING TOPSOIL SHALL BE USED IN ALL PLANT MATERIAL PITS EXCEPT SABAL PALMS WHERE THE SOIL

PLANTING SOIL FOR USE IN BEDS FOR ANNUALS AND/OR PERENNIALS SHALL CONTAIN ONE-THIRD (1/3)
POTTING SOIL OR A BLENDED TOPSOIL: TILL INTO TOP 10" - 12" OF SOIL WITH A TIME-RELEASE FERTILIZER.

PLANT MATERIALS:

PALMS, TREES, SHRUBS, GROUNDCOVERS AND VINES

PLANT SPECIES & SIZE SHALL CONFORM TO THOSE INDICATED ON THE DRAWINGS, NOMENCLATURE SHALL CONFORM TO "STANDARDIZED PLANT NAMES", 1942 ED. ALL NURSERY STOCK SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH "GRADES AND STANDARDS FOR NURSERY PLANTS PARTS | 4 |1", LATEST EDITION PUBLISHED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES, UNLESS SPECIFIED OTHERWISE ALL PLANTS SHALL BE FLORIDA GRADE NIMBER I OR BETTER AS DETERMINED BY THE FLORIDA DIVISION O PLANT INDUSTRY. SPECIMEN MEANS AN EXCEPTIONALLY HEAVY, SYMMETRICAL TIGHTLY KNIT PLANT, SO TRAINED OR FAVORED IN ITS DEVELOPMENT THAT FIRST APPEARANCE IS UNQUESTIONABLE & CUTSTANDINGL. SUPERIOR IN FORT, NUMBER OF BRANCHES, COMPACTNESS AND SYMMETRY. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE FRESHL' DUG, SOUND, HEALTHY, VIGOROUS, WELL BRANCHED AND FREE OF DISEASE AND INSECT EGGS AND LARVAE AND SHALL HAVE ADEQUATE ROOT SYSTEMS. TREES FOR PLANTING ROUG SHALL BE UNFORM IN SIZE AND SHAPE. ALL MATERIALS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE OWNER. WHERE RECUIREMENTS ARE OMITTED FROM THE PLANT LIST, THE PLANTS FURNISHED SHALL BE NORMAL FOR THE VARIETY AND FLORIDA NUMBER! PLANTS SHALL BE PRINED PRIOR TO DELIVERY ONLY UPON THE APPROVAL OF THE OWNER.

CONTAINER GROWN STOCK:

- ALL CONTAINER GROWN MATERIAL SHALL BE HEALTHT, VIGOROUS, WELL-ROOTED PLANTS AND ESTABLISHED IN THE CONTAINER IN WHICH THEY ARE SOLD. THE PLANTS SHALL HAVE TOPS OF GOOD
- 2. AN ESTABLISHED CONTAINER GROWN PLANT SHALL BE TRANSPLANTED INTO A CONTAINER AND GROWN IN THAT CONTAINER SUFFICIENTLY LONG ENOUGH FOR THE NEW FIBROUS ROOTS TO HAVE DEVELOPED SO THAT THE ROOT MASS WILL RETAIN ITS SHAPE AND HOLD TOGETHER WHEN REMOVED FROM THE

WARRANTY

MARRANTY PLANTS, SHRUBS AND TREES FOR A PERIOD OF NINETY (90) DAYS AGAINST DEATH AND UNHEALTHY CONDITION, EXCEPT AS MAY RESULT FROM NEGLECT BY OWNER, DAMAGE BY OTHERS, AND UNUSUAL PHENOMENA BEYOND INSTALLER'S CONTROL. REPLACE AT TIME REQUESTED BY THE CUNIER OR LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT

MAINTENANCE

MAINTAIN LANDSCAPE WORK UNTIL THE LETTER OF SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION BY THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR INCLUDE WATERING, WEEDING, CULTIVATING, RESTORATION OF GRADE, MOUING AND TRIMMING GRASS, FRUNING TREES AND SHRUBS, PROTECTION FROM INSECTS AND DISEASES, FERTILIZATION AND SIMILAR OPERATIONS AS NEEDED TO ENSURE NORMAL GOOD HEALTH FOR LIVE

LAY-OUT NOTES:

- CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL EXISTING CONDITIONS AND LAYOUT DIMENSIONS IN THE FIELD AND REPORT ANY DISCREPANCIES IMMEDIATELY TO THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT FOR REVIEW AND DIRECTION PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. 2. REFER TO ARCHITECTURAL DRAWINGS FOR ALL BUILDING DIMENSIONS.
- 3. CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL EXISTING GRADES IN THE FIELD AND REPORT ANY DISCREPANCIES INTEDIATELY TO THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT FOR REVIEW AND DIRECTION. 4. ALL FILL FOR BERMING & PLANTING BROUGHT TO THE SITE SHALL BE CLEAN, FRIABLE SANDY LOAM OF SLIGHTLY ACID TO NEUTRAL PH. ALL FILL TO BE FREE FROM ROCKS, MARL, SOD & ALL OTHER DEBRIS.
- DELOW FINISH GRADE FOR ALL NEW PLANTING AREAS AND TREE PITS. BACKFILL WITH SUITABLE SOIL AS APPROVED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT. MAINTAIN EXISTING GRADE AT EXISTING TREES. 6. NEW EARTHWORK SHALL BLEND SMOOTHLY INTO EXISTING GRADE. 1. SLOPE EVENLY BETWEEN SPOT GRADES. ALL PAVED AREAS MUST SLOPE TO DRAIN AT MINIMUM OF PER FOOT. ANY SITE CONDITIONS WHICH PREVENT THIS FROM OCCURRING SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.




DRAINAGE NOTES:

MATCH ALL EXISTING GRADES ALONG SIDE PROPERTY LINES TO ADJACENT LOT GRADES. PROVIDE SWALES ON BOTH SIDE PROPERTY LINES, NO WATER SHALL DRAIN ONTO NEIGHBORING

8. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE IRRIGATION AND ELECTRIC SLEEVES TO ALL PLANTERS.

- 3. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING POSITIVE DRAINAGE AWAY FROM ALL STRUCTURES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, BUILDINGS, PLANTERS, COURTYARD PLANTING AREAS, HARDSCAPE SURFACES AND ARCHITECTURAL ELEMENTS.
- 4. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE PIPED DRAINAGE FROM ALL CONFINED PLANTING AREAS 4 PLANTERS






Irregular and Multi-stem Tree

FRONT SHRUB LINE


MAINTAIN 12"W DEAD ZONE AT BED EDGE. SEE PLANTING BED EDGE DETAIL.
