Resolution Approving the First Amendment to the Riviera Beach Community

Redevelopment Agency Budget for Fiscal Year 2015-2016

Attached, please find a proposed First Budget Amendment for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 (Attachment A). The Budget for the Agency was adopted by Resolution 2015-34 at the Regular CRA meeting on September 9, 2015.

Staff requests that the pass-through grant provided to Healthy Food, Healthy Living, Inc., (HFHL) be increased from \$6,000 to \$7,500. The \$1,500 increase will be taken from the Operating Expenses category and be added to the program grant provided to Riviera Beach Community Development Corporation (RBCDC) which will in turn increase the pass-through grant to Healthy Food, Healthy Living, Inc., (HFHL).

This change is requested to accommodate operational expenses for HFHL such as extermination services. The attached chart highlights the specific line items impacted (Attachment B). Please note that there are no net changes in the budget as these expenses merely adjust expenditures within the CRA budget.

As outlined in the attached chart under "HFHL Request," HFHL will still have an unmet financial need in excess of \$5,000 beyond our grant, totaling \$12,557. Upon your review and



discussion, if you are in support of providing additional support to HFHL, up to \$12,557, you could direct us to allocate a portion of the Program Sponsorship money that the CRA is requesting from the City. We have asked the City to support Neighborhood Services Initiatives at \$150,000. This money is currently earmarked for property acquisitions and lien resolutions.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE RIVIERA BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (THE "AGENCY") APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGENCY BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-16, ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED AS EXHIBIT "A"; AUTHORIZING ITS TRANSMITTAL TO THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH FOR CERTIFICATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Agency is responsible for carrying out community redevelopment activities and projects in the community redevelopment area of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Agency is a dependent special district as provided by Section 189.403(2), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the amended budget of the Agency (i) must be passed by a resolution; (ii) include the total amount available from taxation and other sources (iii) include amounts carried over from prior fiscal years; (iv) must equal the total of appropriations for expenditures and reserves; and (v) be presented in accordance with generally acceptable accounting principles. The amended budget must be (a) contained within the general budget of the City of Riviera Beach and be clearly stated as the budget of the dependent district; or (b) with the concurrence of the City of Riviera Beach, budgeted separately, as provided in Section 189.418 (3) and (4), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, with the concurrence of the City of Riviera Beach, the budget of the Agency is budgeted separately; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Agency finds the amended budget to comply with Section 189.418, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Agency desires to accept and approve the First Amendment to Fiscal Year (FY) 2015-16 annual budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE RIVIERA BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY that:

SECTION 1: The recitals and findings contained in the Preamble to the Resolution are incorporated herein as if fully set forth in this section.

SECTION 2: The Board of Commissioners hereby accepts and approves the First Amendment to the FY 2015-16 annual budget attached as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein.

SECTION 3: The Executive Director is hereby authorized to transmit the approved First Amendment to the FY 2015-16 Budget to the City of Riviera Beach for the actions necessary by the City of Riviera Beach including certification in accordance with the law.
