24	business is B1, a resolution of the City Council of the
25	City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida

approving the site plan application from Tepuy

Commercial -- it's known as E-Z Weld -- to develop

7.23 acres of vacant land located at 1301 President

Barack Obama Highway in order to construct a 131,944

square foot building for manufacturing, processing and fabrication.

Additionally, this is associated with item number B2, which is a rezoning of a portion of the parcel, which I will discuss kind of in tandem, but we'll have to have two separate action items.

So again, our staff report is available within the agenda packet tonight. It's also available in the public record book in the back of the chambers.

This is a location map on screen. The current parcel is here, 1301 President Barack Obama Highway. It's the intersection of West -- I need a drink of water -- west 30th Street -- 13th Street -- the intersection of West 13th Street and President Barack Obama Highway.

Currently on the screen is the site plan.

It's difficult to see, however, the building itself -and I do have some architectural elevations further on
in the presentation -- there's a nice architectural
facade along the main roadways. And this is going to
function as the headquarter building for E-Z Weld. And

they're actually currently located just north of here a few blocks. They've been in the city for years and years. I don't even know the exact amount of years, but the applicant is here tonight, so they can provide you that information.

Also in your packet are the landscape plans. There are individual cut sheets to give you the specific details. Here's an elevation looking from 13th Street, so you can see the E-Z Weld sign. And it's an office facility wrapped in the front of the building by the roadway, or facing the roadway, and manufacturing towards the rear. And this would be the view from President Barack Obama Highway. They have, you know, a nice glass elevation on the corner of the intersection, as well as a really nice landscape package. So that will be an improvement to the existing site.

City staff is recommending approval of the site plan application with the conditions stated in the staff packet. I will not read them verbatim unless the Board would like me to. And does the Board have questions?

VICE-CHAIR JAMES: The Board like them read?
What is your pleasure? No, we're good? Okay, there
are no public comments, so we're going to move on to

1 Board comments. 2 Mr. McCoy. 3 MR. McCOY: I have none, Madam Chair. 4 Ms. Shepherd. VICE-CHAIR JAMES: Nothing. But I thank the 5 MS. SHEPHERD: 6 applicant so much, I think for being one of the first 7 using President Barack Obama Highway. That, I think, 8 is speaking all for itself, I think, to be the first 9 one to build. I like that six ADA parking, making it 10 accessible. Just really good, good structure, I think. 11 And just looking to have you to come into the City of 12 Riviera Beach. 13 Thank you, Madam Chair. 14 VICE-CHAIR JAMES: Mr. Whigham. 15 Thank you, Madam Chair. MR. WHIGHAM: 16 I would just like to thank the applicant for 17 coming into our City to build this type of a project 18 I've looked through the blueprint, I've looked here. 19 through the layout, and I think the architect and other 20 engineer that you had looking at this and drawing this 21 up, they did an excellent job. And I think this will 22 be a benefit to our city because you are one, like 23 Ms. Shepherd said, one of the first to build on that 24 highway, Barack Obama Highway. 25 Thank you, Madam Chair.

VICE-CHAIR JAMES: Okay, and I don't have any questions at this time. Is there anything the applicant would like to say?

MR. BRINK: Damian Brink with Jon Schmidt & Associates, for the record, representing the applicant, E-Z Weld.

And we're excited for this facility too. E-Z Weld has been in the community, in Riviera Beach, for over 50 years. They just recently celebrated their 50 year anniversary. And they're looking to expand, create more jobs, and this is an opportunity for them to do that. And they're excited about this new facility. And there may be an opportunity for them to expand on the old site as well, which is in Riviera Beach. So it's an exciting opportunity, and we think it's a great building for the city, and we appreciate all your comments. I'll definitely relay those back to the applicant.

VICE-CHAIR JAMES: Thank you. One more comment, since you mentioned that. If they can, if they can try to make sure they hire locally.

MR. BRINK: Currently there are 53 employees at the site just up the road, and 20 percent of them are Riviera Beach residents. And they will continue that trend as they -- if they hire more folks at the

new facility. 1 2 VICE-CHAIR JAMES: Okay, for the construction 3 as well. 4 MR. BRINK: Absolutely. 5 VICE-CHAIR JAMES: Thank you. 6 MS. SHEPHERD: Madam Chair. 7 Ms. Shepherd. VICE-CHAIR JAMES: 8 The old facility, because I MS. SHEPHERD: 9 pass by there and I see a lot of work going on there, 10 will you all be closing down that site and move over to 11 the new site, or will you keep both of them running? 12 So their current plans, they MR. BRINK: 13 would like to build a pipe manufacturing. Part of 14 their business is the cement and the PVC piping. 15 That's the current plan, is to try to use that facility 16 as a new pipe manufacturing facility. That's the 17 current plan. If that falls through or the site is not 18 adequate for it, they may lease the space to another 19 Those are the two kind of options on the table 20 Nothing has been decided yet though. right now. 21 MS. SHEPHERD: So you're just not sure Okav. 22 how you're going to utilize it, you're just --23 MR. BRINK: Right now it's just -- right now 24 the plan is to move into the new facility for the 25 current E-Z Weld and what they currently do now. And

1 the plan may be to open up a pipe manufacturing, which 2 would create more jobs and utilize that facility. Ιf 3 it can't handle that, then they may lease it to 4 They're going to retain ownership for now and another. 5 maybe lease it to another company that could fit into 6 there. 7 Okay. Once again, welcome. MS. SHEPHERD: Ι 8 see you guys are very busy, because it's open up at 9 night and you can see your workers that work in there. 10 That's an A plus to me. I thank you for that. 11 MR. BRINK: I will pass that on too. 12 MS. SHEPHERD: Thank you. 13 VICE-CHAIR JAMES: Thank you. Any other 14 Board comments? Okay, is there a motion? 15 Madam Chair, just one thing. Are MR. McCOY: 16 we doing the site plan, or are we doing the zoning 17 designation change right now? 18 We're doing -- we're on VICE-CHAIR JAMES: 19 So that is the application. 20 MR. McCOY: Madam Chair, I was actually 21 speaking to staff, because I wanted to kind of 22 elaborate. 23 Wouldn't the zoning designation change 24 generally come first? 25 MR. GAGNON: You know, it's happening,

occurring almost simultaneously. We could do the other order, but technically, it would go to the City Council as an ordinance, so it would just be a different item in general. So --

MR. McCOY: I heard that come up at the last meeting why we're approving a site plan if the designation hasn't changed first in a different situation. But you said you were doing them in tandem, so I thought this was going to be the one and only presentation. So are you going to go through the presentation?

MR. GAGNON: Oh, I can continue with the rezoning as well. It seemed as if the Board wanted to get to the site plan first, so --

VICE-CHAIR JAMES: We can go ahead and go with the second one as well before we take a vote.

MR. GAGNON: Sure. So B2 would be an ordinance of the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, amending the zoning designation of a portion of a parcel of land located at 1301 President Barack Obama Highway, parcel control number 56-43-42-33-00-000-3010, from a limited industrial zoning designation to a general industrial zoning designation.

So currently on the screen, it's a section of

the City zoning map. This is the parcel in question, and currently this IL designation, the light blue color is limited industrial zoning. This darker blue color is general industrial zoning. The proposal is to rezone that IL portion to IG, so that way it will be one uniform zoning district on this parcel. Really, the intent of this is to make sure that there is no conflict with the manufacturing.

So as the building elevations demonstrated previously, there will be a nice architectural element along President Barack Obama Highway, and along West 13th Street as well. But we just wanted to make sure that the internal workings were all in compliance with our zoning code. And that's really the reason why we wanted to rezone this parcel, or really a portion of the parcel.

And staff is recommending approval of the zoning amendment.

VICE-CHAIR JAMES: Okay, there are no public comments, so we'll move over to Board comments.
