2/27/2016

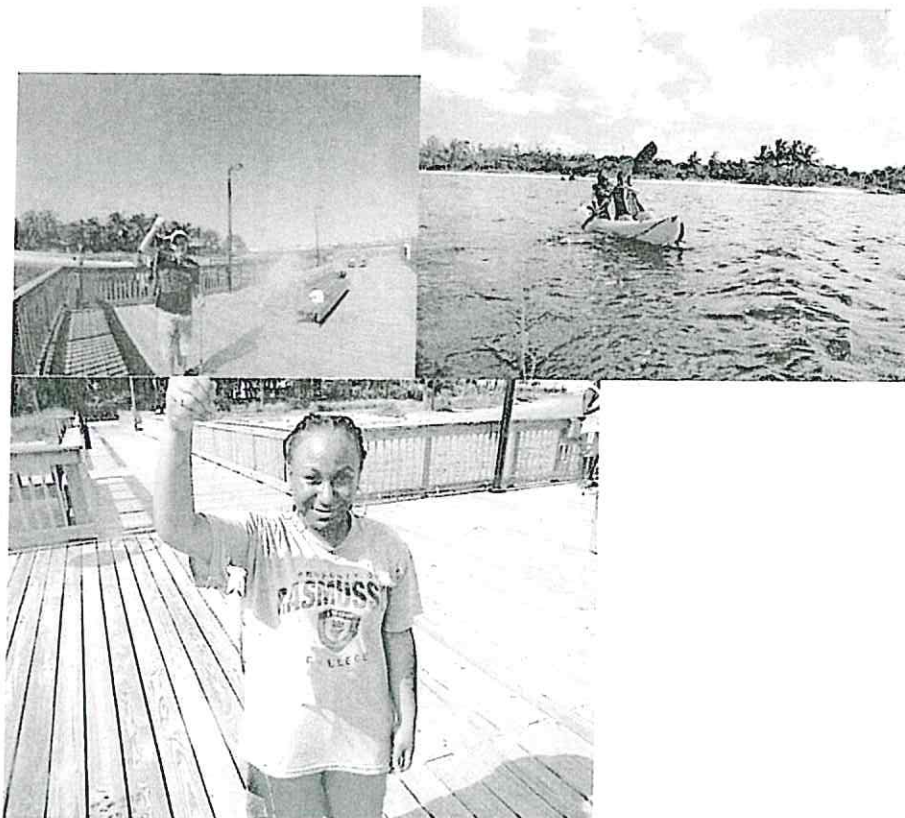
