




Riviera's marina could give city reboot

If I wanted to turn around the image of a city, I'd put my money on a marina and a waterfront, too. Dock slips with expensive yachts and views of an island in the Intraviews of an island in the Intra-coastal, plus nice restaurants and entertaliment, sound like a plausible combination to lure investment and foot traffic to your city. Which is why, a decade from now, we may have a very dif-ferent view of Riviera Beach than we do today. The starting point is the marina.

than we do today.

The starting point is the marina.

"Right now, that's our main draw," said Scott Evans, planning and development director with the city's Community Redevelopment Agency.

There are a lot of people already coming to the marina, the waterfront. Our goal is to drive a lot more people here. So the city is investing \$35 million to build a marina village. A Marina Event Center is already open, with close to 7,000 square feet of banquet hall space to host weddings, corporate events and more. Officials say it's booked every weekend for the rest of 2016. Just this month, they kicked off an every-Saturday Green and Artisan Market. Another landmark moment is scheduled for Saturday evening: a concert on the green space between the event center and a water park on the north end of the property. The featured performer is saxophonist and flutist Najee.

Last week, they announced a new tenant for cafe space inside the event center. Rafiki Tiki, owned by local businessman Demetri Solloum, will take up about 2,600 square feet of indoor and outdoor space on the building's first floor.

More restaurants are

More restaurants are planned, as many as a handful depending on spacing.

Solloum sald the marina village project represents more than an opportunity to make money. He, too, believes it's a chance to bring new life to a city that needs a definite change in the way the rest of Palm Beach County sees it.

"This place means a lot to me," said Solloum, a 27-year resident of the area. "We want something to improve the city, not just to start a business."

Nonetheless, Economic Development 101 says the proliferation of profitable businesses is the cornerstone of any area's revival.

nesses is the cornerstone of any area's revival. And local businesses, spe-cifically, added City Commis-sioner Ternece Davis. He said the city is simply putting infra-structure pieces in place for nearby merchants, entrepre-neurs and store owners to thrive.

"It draws people in and, more importantly, gives them a way to make money at this location," he said. The CRA's Evans said other

The CRA's Evans sald other pieces need to be in place first, though. By 2020, the marina village should be built out with parking garage (400 to 600 spaces), as many as 40 more dock slips, the restaurants, weekly entertainment options and a year-round public market. That, he said, will boost redesuite market of the procedure of redevelopment along Broad-way to the west – and beyond. If so, it would change the story that is so often written

story that Is so often written about this city of 33,000 people – from a narrative about crime, poverty and political shenanigans to a healthler focus on business opportunity generated by a public gathering point.

"Those are the tie-ins we want to talk about," Davis said.
